Билет №2. The Russian Federation

Hello, my name is _____ and I'm going to speak about my country.

The Russian Federation is the largest country in the world. It occupies about one-seventh of the earth's surface. It's total area is about 17 million square kilometers. The country is washed by 12 seas of 3 oceans: the Pacific, the Atlantic, the Arctic. Russia borders with many countries. They are: Korea [kə'ri:ə], China [tʃaɪnə], Mongolia [mɒŋ'gəʊliə], Kazakhstan [kæzæk'stɑ:n], Georgia [dʒə:dʒiə] Грузия, Azerbaijan [æzəbaɪ'dʒɑ:n], Norway [nɔ:'weɪ] Норвегия, Finland ['fɪnlənd] Финляндия, the Baltic states (страны Балтии - Estonia [es'təʊniə], Latvia [lætviə], Lithuania [liθju'eɪniə]), Poland, Belorussia [beləu'rʌʃə] and the Ukraine [ju:'kreɪn]. It also has a sea border with the USA. The population of the Russian Federation is nearly 250 million people. The capital of the country is Moscow. It's its largest political, scientific, cultural and economic center. Russia has 13 cities with over a million inhabitants (from largest to smallest): Moscow, Saint Petersburg, Novosibirsk, Yekaterinburg, Nizhny Novgorod, Samara, Omsk, Kazan, Chelyabinsk, Rostov-on-Don, Ufa, Volgograd and Perm.

Russia is very rich in mineral resources [rɪ'zɔ:sɪz]. **There is** gold, platinum ['plætɪnəm] платина, diamonds ['daɪəməndz] алмазы, coal [kəʊl] уголь, peat [pi:t] торф, oil (нефть), gas [gæs] and wood. **There are** over two million rivers in Russia. The Europe's biggest river, **the Volga**, flows into the Caspian sea. Others main rivers are: the Ob [əʊb], the Yenisei [ˌjenɪ'seɪ], the Lena ['leɪnə] and the Amur [ə'muə]. Russia is also rich in beautiful lakes. The world biggest lake - the Caspian sea ['kæspɪən si:] and the world deepest lake - Lake Baikal [leɪk baɪ'kɑ:l] are in it.

Russia has one-six of the world's forests. They are concentrated in the European north of the country, in Siberia and in Far East. The climate in Russia varies from the arctic in the north to subtropical in the south. In the middle of the country the climate is continental. Russia has four beautiful seasons: winter, spring, summer and autumn.

The Russian Federation is a parliamentary republic. The Head of State is the President, who is commander-in-chief of the armed forces. He is elected for 4 years and his powers are limited by the Duma. The head of the government is the Prime Minister.

The Russian flag has three horizontal stripes: **white, blue and red**. Besides the flag, there is another national symbol of Russia. It is **a two-headed eagle**.

Tourists usually come to Russia to visit Moscow, St. Petersburg and other cities. Russia is a wonderful place to live but also to visit. **That is all I wanted to tell you about my country.**
